





6 SAINT NICHOLAS DAY Saint Nicholas is a Christian holiday (in Eastern Christian countries it is celbrated on 19th december) which commemorates the saint Nicholas, who is known for selling all his possessions and helping the poor. He is also the inspiration for Santa Claus.

24 CHRISTMAS EVE the day before the birth of Jesus Christ. People usually decorate Christmas tree and sing carols, traditional Christmas songs and go to the midnight mass.

**25 CHRISTMAS DAY** marks the birth of Jesus Christ.

**26 SAINT STEPHEN'S DAY** commemorates Christian martyr St Stephen and is a public holiday in Croatia and Italy. Eastern Christian churches celebrate it on 27th december.
